1. Develop an open government data action plan, based on feedback gathered from the open data community and government officials

3. Publish the action plan	
Start date: 1 July 2017	End date: 30 July 2017
4. Develop a public dashboard for reporting against the action plan goals	
Start date: 1 August 2017	End date: 30 August 2017
5. Seek public feedback on the proposed public dashboard	
Start date: 1 Sept 2017	End date: 15 Sept 2017
6. Regularly update the public dashboard on government progress toward the goals	
Start date: 16 Sept 2017	End date: 30 June 2018
